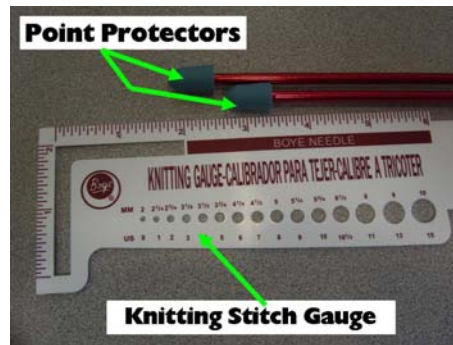


## You CAN Knit! – Updated Knitting Basics

### Beginners' Supply List

You will need to bring the following supplies to class with you. They can be purchased at Walmart, Joann's fabric store, Hobby Lobby, or Michaels craft store. Occasionally, Hobby Lobby has a 40% off coupon available on their website ([www.hobbylobby.com](http://www.hobbylobby.com)). Michaels usually has a discount coupon in their sales insert for the Sunday paper.

- knitting needles, either 9-inch or 11-inch length. They can be aluminum, bamboo, or plastic (acrylic) – the choice is yours;
- skein of size 5 yarn. The instructor notes that a thicker yarn is easier to learn with than the regular thin yarn. A good brand to purchase is Lion Brand Wool-Ease Chunky or Wool-Ease Thick & Quick. The following is a picture of yarn label showing where to find size:



Be sure to choose a yarn that is smooth; the novelty yarns that are fuzzy, knobby, etc. are more difficult to work with for beginners.

- stitch gauge
- point protectors (to keep your stitches on your needles when not in use).
- pair of scissors
- scarf pattern

## Free Knitting Pattern - Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Chunky Two-Hour Knit Scarf

**Pattern Number:** 80680AD

This classic scarf is fun, fast, and fabulous. A great first-time project.

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner

**SIZE:** One Size  
About 7 x 60 in. (18 x 152.5 cm)

### MATERIALS

- 2 Balls Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Chunky Yarn: Bluebell **OR** color of your choice
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 19 [15 mm]
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

### GAUGE:

7 sts + 12 rows = 4 in (10 cm) in Garter stitch (knit every row). **BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### NOTES:

Scarf is knitted with 2 strands of yarn held together.

### SCARF

With 2 strands of yarn, cast on 12 sts.  
Work even in Garter stitch (knit every row) for 60 in. (152.5 cm).  
Bind off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
